



## Learning Options for Students in Grades 7 - 12

**\*\*NOTE\*\*:** In all three of these options, students will continue to be Donegal School District students. This means they may participate in school events, activities, sports and extracurricular offerings.

<u>In-Person Learning</u>	<u>Donegal Online Learning</u>	<u>Donegal Virtual Academy</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will be assigned a schedule with a Donegal teacher for each class</li> <li>• The curriculum being taught will be the Donegal School District curriculum</li> <li>• Students will follow the classroom schedule five days per week with adjustments being made to follow the guidelines in the approved Health and Safety plan.</li> <li>• Students will have an opportunity to interact with their peers in their class who are participating in online learning.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will be assigned a schedule with a Donegal teacher for each class</li> <li>• The curriculum being taught will be the Donegal School District curriculum</li> <li>• Students will participate in live, online instruction following their schedules each day for (approximately) three-four hours per day (this will be based on children's age and content being taught). These times will be communicated to students/families on a weekly basis. Classes will also be recorded to watch later.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will not be assigned to a Donegal classroom teacher. They are taught by online teachers from a different organization.</li> <li>• The curriculum being taught will not be Donegal curriculum, but curriculum created by an online learning provider.</li> <li>• Students may access lessons at any time. Teacher assistance is available upon request.</li> <li>• This option provides more independent, self-paced learning.</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Taking into account our Health &amp; Safety Plan, a variety of collaborative learning opportunities will be a part of in-person learning. For example, students might be working on a research project together using Google.</li><li>• Grading and assessments will be completed as they would have prior to March 2020.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students will independently complete learning activities at home for the remainder of their day. These assignments are required and will be used for the purpose of grading and/or attendance.</li><li>• Students may need to pick up supplies for coursework or, if families are unable to do this, students may need to occasionally participate in alternate activities.</li><li>• Grading and assessments will be completed at home and be provided to the teacher electronically.</li><li>• The Donegal teacher will facilitate collaborative learning opportunities with classmates.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Grading and attendance will be completed by the online learning provider.</li></ul>
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
