

Learning Options for Students in Grades 7 - 12

****NOTE**:** In all three of these options, students will continue to be Donegal School District students. This means they may participate in school events, activities, sports and extracurricular offerings.

In-Person Learning	Donegal Online Learning	Donegal Virtual Academy
 Students will be assigned a schedule with a Donegal teacher for each class The curriculum being taught will be the Donegal School District curriculum Students will follow the classroom schedule five days per week with adjustments being made to follow the guidelines in the approved Health and Safety plan. Students will have an opportunity to interact with their peers in their class who are participating in online learning. 	 Students will be assigned a schedule with a Donegal teacher for each class The curriculum being taught will be the Donegal School District curriculum Students will participate in live, online instruction following their schedules each day for (approximately) three-four hours per day (this will be based on children's age and content being taught). These times will be communicated to students/families on a weekly basis. Classes will also be recorded to watch later. 	 Students will not be assigned to a Donegal classroom teacher. They are taught by online teachers from a different organization. The curriculum being taught will not be Donegal curriculum, but curriculum created by an online learning provider. Students may access lessons at any time. Teacher assistance is available upon request. This option provides more independent, self-paced learning.

- Taking into account our Health & Safety Plan, a variety of collaborative learning opportunities will be a part of in-person learning. For example, students might be working on a research project together using Google.
- Grading and assessments will be completed as they would have prior to March 2020.
- Students will independently complete learning activities at home for the remainder of their day. These assignments are required and will be used for the purpose of grading and/or attendance.
- Students may need to pick up supplies for coursework or, if families are unable to do this, students may need to occasionally participate in alternate activities.
- Grading and assessments will be completed at home and be provided to the teacher electronically.
- The Donegal teacher will facilitate collaborative learning opportunities with classmates.

• Grading and attendance will be completed by the online learning provider.
