**\*\*NOTE\*\*** - In all three of these options, students will continue to be Donegal School District students. This means they may participate in school events, activities, sports and extracurricular offerings.

They are taught by online teachers from a different organization.</li> <li>● The curriculum being taught will not be Donegal curriculum, but curriculum created by an online learning provider.</li> <li>● Students may access lessons at any time. Teacher assistance is</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students will have an opportunity to interact with their peers in their class who are participating in online learning.</li><li>• Taking into account our Health &amp; Safety Plan, a variety of collaborative learning opportunities will be a part of in-person learning. For example, students might be working on a research project together using Google.</li><li>• Grading and assessments will be completed as they would have prior to March 2020.</li><li>• Recess will be scheduled so that multiple classes are not on the playground at the same time.</li></ul>	<p>children's' ages). These times will be communicated to parents on a weekly basis. Classes will also be recorded to watch later.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students will have an opportunity to have social interactions with their peers through the use of technology.</li><li>• The Donegal teacher will facilitate collaborative learning opportunities with classmates.</li><li>• Younger students will need significant support from parents/guardians to assist students with computer access, completing assignments and engaging in classroom learning.</li><li>• Students will independently complete learning activities at home for the remainder of their day. These assignments are required and will be used for the purpose of grading and/or attendance.</li><li>• Students may need to pick up supplies for coursework or, if families are unable to do this, students may need to occasionally</li></ul>	<p>available upon request.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• This option provides more independent, self-paced learning.</li><li>• Younger students will need significant support from parents/guardians to assist students with computer access and completing assignments.</li><li>• Grading and attendance will be completed by the online learning provider.</li></ul>
